Plant disease - Soil pH: Soil pH, a measure of acidity or alkalinity, markedly influences a few diseases, such as common scab of potato and clubroot of crucifers (*Plasmodiophora brassicae*). Growth of the potato scab organism is suppressed at a pH of 5.2 or slightly below (pH 7 is neutral; numbers below 7 indicate acidity, and those above 7 indicate alkalinity).

Density Dependent Factors Definition. Density dependent factors affect a population through increasing or decreasing birth and death rates, in a way that is directly related to the density of the population. Unlike density independent factors, which are not tied to the population density, density dependent factors change how they affect the population as the population changes in size.
