Difference between Allopatric and Sympatric Speciation

On the origin of allopatric primate species 119 successively isolated breeding colony is, or the farther it has moved from the center of that taxon's dispersion, the nearer it will come to the end of its metachromic evolution. And, the narrower will be its range of chromic fitness (e.g., prey and predator camouflage).

Allopatric Speciation. A geographically continuous population has a gene pool that is relatively homogeneous. Gene flow, the movement of alleles across the range of the species, is relatively free because individuals can move and then mate with individuals in their new location.
